



Eveniment: Prezentarea Raportului final de țară PSF – 8 iunie 2022

Ministerul Cercetării, Inovării și Digitalizării (MCID) va organiza evenimentul de prezentare a raportului final de țară, realizat cu ajutorul Mecanismului de sprijin al politicilor (Policy Support Facility – PSF), pe 8 iunie 2022, în Amfiteatrul Ion Heliade Rădulescu al Bibliotecii Academiei Române.

Delegația experților PSF va prezenta raportul final în fața conducerii MCID și a principalilor actori din domeniul cercetare, dezvoltare și inovare. Vor fi prezentate principalele cauze identificate ale dezechilibrelor actuale din sistemul național CDI, precum și principalele recomandări ce vor fi implementate pentru a accede spre o mai bună integrare în Spațiul European al Cercetării și pentru a reduce decalajele în ceea ce privește ansamblul indicatorilor specifici de țară în ceea ce privește domeniul CDI.

Domnul Sebastian-Ioan Burduja, ministrul cercetării, inovării și digitalizării, va prezida reuniunea la care vor participa: domnul Jean-Eric Paquet – director general Direcția Generală pentru Cercetare și Inovare UE, doamna Ligia Deca – consilier prezidențial, domnul Sorin-Valentin Costreie – consilier de stat al prim-ministrului, miniștri, secretari de stat, directorii generali al institutelor naționale de cercetare și dezvoltare, rectori, experți tehnici, reprezentanți ai consiliilor consultative MCID și ai societății civile.

Unitatea de Implementare a Reformelor PSF (UIRPFS) din cadrul MCID îndeplinește rolul de suport pentru procesul de evaluare PSF a sistemului CDI. UIRPFS, împreună cu direcțiile de specialitate din cadrul MCID, are rol în implementarea recomandărilor primite de la experții PSF, pentru a asigura succesul reformelor din cadrul Planului Național de Redresare și Reziliență – Componenta 9. Suport pentru Sectorul Privat, Cercetare, Dezvoltare și Inovare (<https://mfe.gov.ro/pnrr>).

KEY FINDINGS AND REFORM PRIORITIES	
	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The foundation of Romania's research and innovation system is not sufficiently solid to support the country's move towards becoming a knowledge-based economy2. Under-funding and mis-funding3. Fragmentation and weak effectiveness of public research4. An unbalanced policy mix for R&I5. Fragmentation and lack of vision at governmental level6. Improved inclusiveness but ongoing low effectiveness of strategies7. Public-private cooperation happening at a small scale in spite of the system's unfavourable features8. A growing role for regions in the national R&I system9. A serious lack of policy-relevant evidence to guide R&I policy10. Ineffective practices in the public sector generally hindering R&I policy implementation11. Unattractive framework conditions for human resources in the R&I sector12. The brain-drain and weak international position as major threats
KEY POLICY MESSAGE	
	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Reinforce the overall governance of the R&I system through cross-governmental coordination and inclusion of the voice of society into this system2. Ensure predictability and effectiveness of public funding for the R&I system3. Foster the use of policy intelligence to support better strategic governance of the R&I system4. Launch an in-depth, evidence-based consolidation process of the four pillars of public research performers, to gradually transform this fragmented landscape into a 'system' of centres of excellence and centres of competence in strong priority domains5. Improve governance at the level of public research institutions and adjust institutional funding sources towards performance-based funding channels, minimising the administrative burden6. Provide a better environment for human resources in the public research system7. Develop a sound strategy for research infrastructure ensuring alignment with national priorities, sustainability and openness8. Foster public-private partnerships in research9. Offer more effective support for the internationalisation of Romanian research actors, relying on a more focused internationalisation strategy and stronger incentives for 'brain circulation'10. Reinforce the role of EU Cohesion Policy Funds to support R&I in Romania through greater political support, enhanced synergies between programmes and improved implementation quality
